			<p>When delivering swimming lessons teachers should adhere to government guidance on social distancing.</p> <p>Allow sufficient time between lessons for cleaning and to reduce the chance of clustering groups.</p> <p>All equipment should be sanitised before and after each activity.</p>	<p>This will be from other staff and parents /carers .</p> <p>Parents to be asked not to arrive early for lessons ,To come at their allocated time .And leave ASAP after their child's lesson.</p> <p>Teachers to clean all equipment at the end of the lesson or put into a used box and all equipment will be cleaned at the end of the morning /evening prior</p>

			<p>exiting the pool .</p> <p>Limit interactions with staff and phone or email questions where possible.</p> <p>Use sanitizer whilst in the area</p> <p>Social distance from other families.</p> <p>Asked not to attend if their child or a member of their household displays ANY symptoms.</p> <p>Staff will reserve the right to ask anyone to leave they feel is unwell .Asking parents to abide by this rule.</p> <p>The pool will be laid out so classes are social distancing for children and staff.</p> <p>Lane swimming will be no more than 3 in a lane and where possible will be children from the same family.</p> <p>Lanes empty in-between where numbers allow.</p> <p>Adaptations to be made for swimmers with SEN .</p>
